- Excellent, low-cost investment products, including over 80 mutual funds
- Fully liquid investment products guaranteeing principal and interest that offer annual interest rates up to a 3.5% return with no penalty or charge for withdrawal
- No administrative, maintenance, or commission fees
- Tax deferred growth
- Full account value for you and your beneficiaries, with no restrictions or limitations

If you intend to roll funds out of the Plan, carefully review any fees, restrictions, and commissions that may be imposed by another investment product.

As a Deferred Compensation Plan Participant, you have the advantage to consolidate other pre-tax retirement accounts into the Deferred Compensation Plan, such as:

- 401k, 403b, 401a, and IRAs
- DROP and FRS Investment Plan accounts
- Annual and Sick Leave (all or a portion of it)
